Worship God – Read John 12:12-18.

Easter Celebration Worship at 8:15, 9:30, & 11:00.

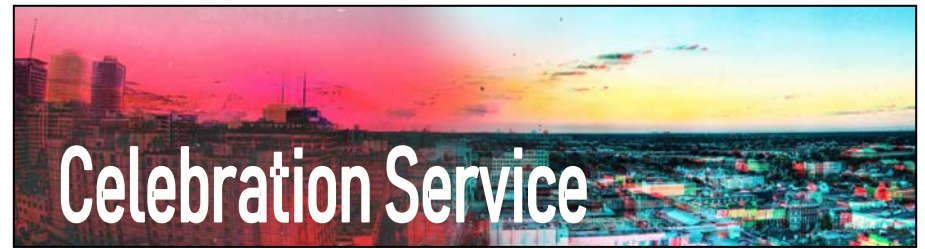
