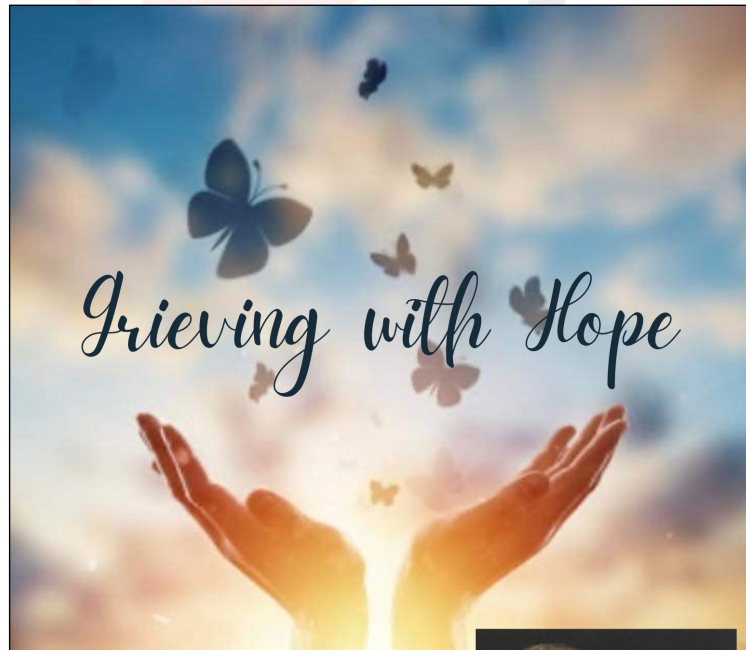

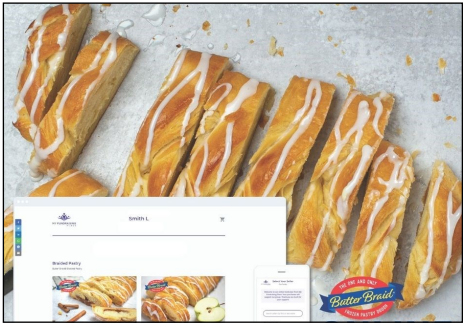

As the daughter of the famed blue-skinned, Troublesome Creek packhorse librarian, Honey and her family have been hiding from the law all her life. But when her mother and father are imprisoned, Honey realizes she must fight to stay free or risk being sent away for good.

Picking up her mother's old packhorse library route, Honey begins to deliver books to the remote hollers of Appalachia. Honey is looking to prove that she doesn't need anyone telling her how to survive. But the route can be treacherous, and some folks aren't as keen to let a woman pave her own way.

If Honey wants to bring the freedom books provide to the families who need it most, she's going to have to fight for her place, and along the way, learn that the extraordinary women who run the hills and hollers can make all the difference in the world.

Operation Christmas Child

Jesus has commissioned us to “go and make disciples of all nations” (Matthew 28:19 NIV). One of the ways we strive to fulfill Jesus’ commission, our mission, is by partnering with ministries to reach people in places our church has not gone and probably will not go. During the past seven years, the people of Avon UMC have blessed more than 1,300 children through the ministry of Operation Christmas Child. When children receive a shoebox full of gifts, they are given a booklet that summarizes Jesus’ story in their own language as well as invited to a 12-week discipleship class called, “The Greatest Journey”, which is hosted by a local congregation in their community. By participating in Operation Christmas Child our congregation blesses kids, helps to introduce children and families to Jesus, and partners with churches throughout the world to make disciples of Christ.



You can participate again this year or for the first time. Participating in filling OCC shoeboxes with gifts is a great way for parents and grandparents to involve their children or grandchildren in blessing other kids. Many Avon UMC families have each of their children or grandchildren fill a shoebox for a child their own age and gender. Parents and grandparents can invite the children and/or the teens of their family to give their own money to buy the gifts or pay for shipping. Serving and giving are ways that we grow in faith and Christ-likeness, so inviting your children or grandchildren to participate is another way to guide them on their journey of following Jesus.

Boxes, etc. - Empty shoeboxes, packing lists, shoebox labels, and a list of gift suggestions are available at tables outside of the Chapel and in or outside of the Sanctuary.

November 12th - Filled shoeboxes with labels on them must be returned to the drop off location at Avon UMC near the Sanctuary by the end of the day on Sunday, the 12th of November.

\$10 donation - A donation of \$10 per shoebox will help with shipping and transporting them to the children who will receive them. Checks may be written to Avon UMC with “OCC shoeboxes” on the memo line. To give electronically use the “Give Online” icon on the website, select “Special - Other” on the drop down menu, then type “OCC shoeboxes” in the Memo box.

Handicrafts can spark
appreciation for simple items.
Weave this basket as a gift.



What you need:

- Paper plate
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Yarn (different colors)

What you do:

1. In the center of the plate, trace something round. Draw 9 lines (evenly spaced) from the circle to the plate's edge.
2. Cut along each line, stopping at the center circle. Trim more of the plate off so the cuts make a gradual V shape.
3. Fold the plate's sides upward to form basket sides. Keep these upright as you weave a bowl-shaped basket.
4. Begin weaving a length of yarn at the circle's base. Hold the end of the yarn in place as you spread the length over and under each side of the plate.
5. Switch colors to make a pattern. Keep the yarn tight as you weave up the sides.
6. To finish, bend down any remaining paper. Leave a tail of yarn and tuck it under a woven portion. Share your craft with a friend!
