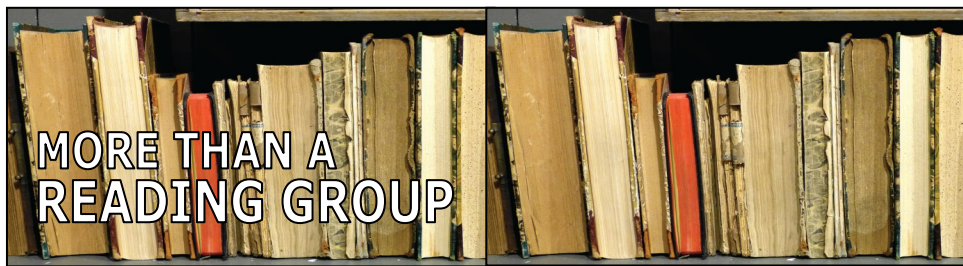


Dream Car and Lasting Impact

More Than a Book Club will meet on February 19th to discuss *The Bill Cook Story: Ready, Fire, Aim*, by Bob Hammel.

Bill Cook epitomized the American success story. His business ventures in medical devices, pharmaceuticals, genetics, real estate, retail management, and travel services made him a billionaire. Yet, Cook continued to lead a modest life, involving himself in a variety of philanthropic activities that included historic preservation and even a marching band. This riveting story is the first-ever biography of the entrepreneur who, working from the spare bedroom of his Bloomington, Indiana, apartment in 1963 with a \$1,500 investment, began to construct the wire guides, needles, and catheters that would become the foundation of the global multi-billion-dollar Cook Group. Biographer Bob Hammel, with extraordinary access to Cook, his files, and his associates, has created a vivid portrait of this modern, multidimensional Horatio Alger — quirky humor, widely varied interests, and all. Informative and inspiring, this book celebrates an exceptional self-made individual.

Stephen Ministry Training Update

CROSS OF ASHES — On Ash Wednesday, as Lent begins, worshipers' foreheads are often marked with ashes in the sign of the cross. The ashes traditionally come from burning palm branches from the previous Palm Sunday. In the Old Testament, ashes were a sign of mourning and repentance. Today, some worshipers wipe off the ashes before leaving church, to symbolize being cleansed from sin by Jesus' death; others wear the ashes the rest of the day, carrying the cross of Christ into the world. Reciting Genesis 3:19 often accompanies the placement of ashes: "You are dust, and to dust you shall return."



From the Health Ministry Team...



As I am writing this article it is 6 degrees with a wind chill advisory in effect. I have just returned from Florida - the Sunshine State, and I saw the sun for maybe three hours! I miss the sun; I miss the need to wear sunglasses! I do not like this weather, but I know it will change and my mood will improve. However, some people have trouble with the “winter blues”. It is a condition called seasonal affective disorder (SAD).

SAD is a type of depression characterized by a recurrent seasonal pattern, with symptoms lasting about 4-5 months out of the year. Symptoms of depression for SAD can include oversleeping, overeating, particularly with a craving for carbohydrates, social withdrawal (feeling like “hibernating”). Treatments are available to help people with SAD. They fall into four main categories that can be used alone or in combination: light therapy, Vitamin D, psychotherapy, & antidepressant medication.

The National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH) has information on ways to get help and find health care provider or access treatment at www.nimh.nih.gov/findhelp.

It is estimated that millions of Americans experience SAD, although many may not know they have this common disorder. In most cases, SAD begins in young adulthood. SAD occurs much more often in women than in men.

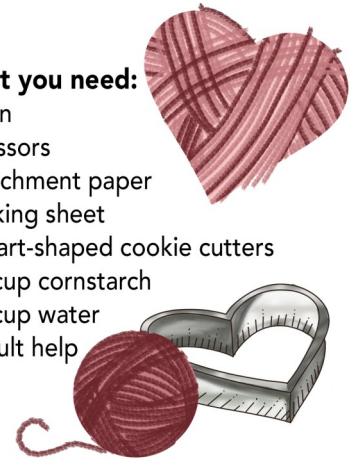

HEART strings

Make this heartfelt craft
as a decoration or gift.

What you need:

- Yarn
- Scissors
- Parchment paper
- Baking sheet
- Heart-shaped cookie cutters
- ¼ cup cornstarch
- ½ cup water
- Adult help



What you do:

1. Cut yarn into 12-inch pieces.
2. Place cookie cutters atop a baking sheet lined with parchment paper.
3. Combine cornstarch and water in a saucepan. Heat mixture over medium heat, stirring until thick and smooth. Remove from heat and cool to form a "glue."
4. Dip each piece of yarn into the mixture to coat completely. Squeeze off any excess.
5. Place yarn in the cookie cutters, allowing pieces to cross and loop within the heart. Add more until the cookie cutter is filled and the yarn looks like a heart.
6. Remove cookie cutters and bake the sheet for two hours at 150°F, or until hearts are dry and hard.
