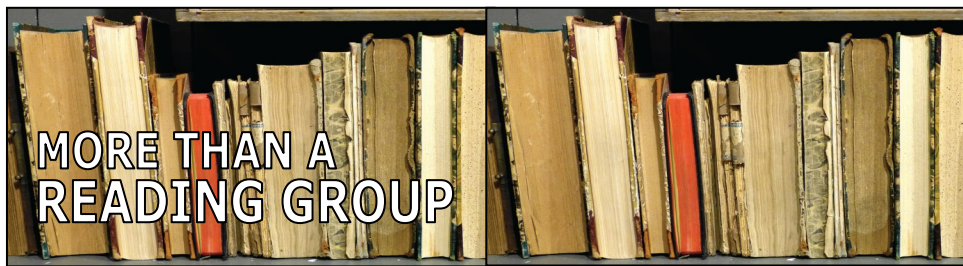

More Than a Book Club will meet on Monday, July 15th 6:30 pm in the main narthex to discuss *The Housekeeper and the Professor* by Yoko Ogawa. This is an enchanting story about what it means to live in the present, and about the curious equations that can create a family. He is a brilliant math Professor with a peculiar problem — ever since a traumatic head injury, he has lived with only eighty minutes of short-term memory.

She is an astute young Housekeeper with a ten-year-old son who is hired to care for the Professor.

Every morning, as the Professor and the Housekeeper are introduced to each other anew, a strange and beautiful relationship blossoms between them. Though he cannot hold memories for long (his brain is like a tape that begins to erase itself every eighty minutes), the Professor's mind is still alive with elegant equations from the past. And the numbers, in all of their articulate order, reveal a sheltering and poetic world to both the Housekeeper and her young son. The Professor is capable of discovering connections between the simplest of quantities — like the Housekeeper's shoe size — and the universe at large, drawing their lives ever closer and more profoundly together, even as his memory slips away.

This little gem of a book was first published in Japanese in 2003. The translation is well done and packed full of beautiful stories, analogies and memories. It is a book you will not easily forget. Join us! For more information contact Jane DuMond at bjdumond@sbcglobal.net.



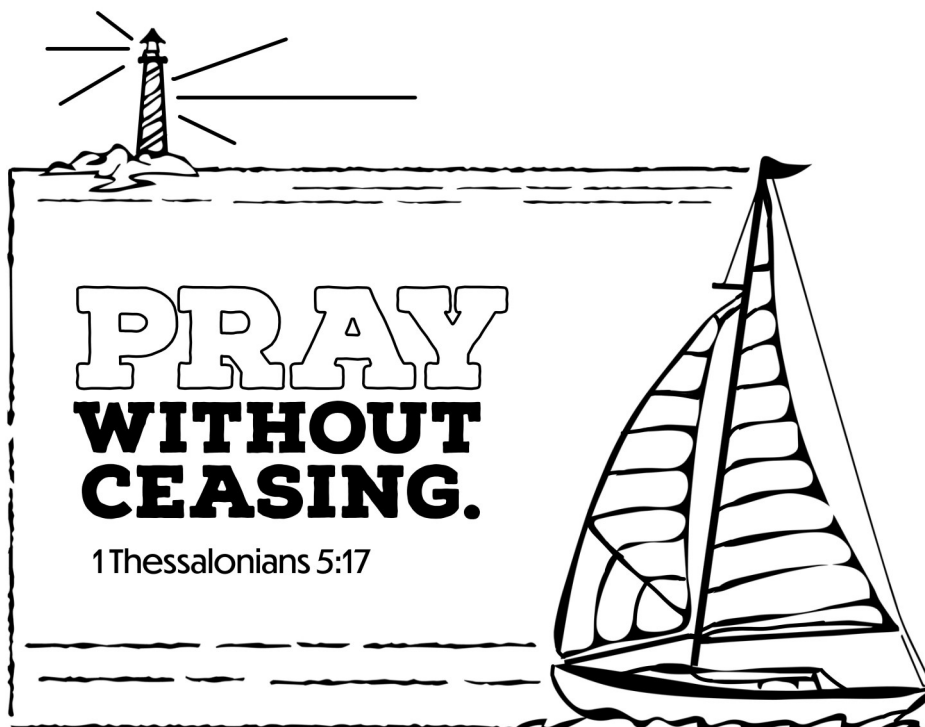

From the Health Ministry Team...



Dog days of summer are here, let's talk about sun safety. Sunshine is wonderful for the soul and body for vitamin D. Here are some useful practices to prevent sunburn and more importantly skin cancer.

Apply sunscreen regularly every two hours. Using spray or lotion with SPF 30 or more, please rub it in. If using spray, don't spray your face. Spray

hands and rub it on face. Also apply about 15 minutes before being exposed to sun and participating in any water activities. Use a broad-spectrum sunscreen with can effectively protect against both UVA and UVB rays from the sun.

Clothing can help too in prevention of sun sunburn and cancer. Ultraviolet Protection Factor (UPF) is a measurement that indicates what percentage of the sun's rays penetrate your clothing. All clothing has some level of UPF protection, but not all has UPF label. UPF label clothing is specifically designed to shield you from UV rays.

There is no perfect way to fully protect yourself from the sun. A combination approach of sunscreen SPF 30 or higher and clothing to protect exposed areas is the best way.

Also check your sunscreen, there is an expiration date. The expiration date shows testing the product will remain stable for three years. Also, look for visible signs that your sunscreen is different in color or consistency. High temperature exposure can break down the ingredients of the lotion/spray thus losing effectiveness.

We will meet July 14th at 4:00 pm in the Fellowship Hall. We will be having picnic foods and playing some yard games.

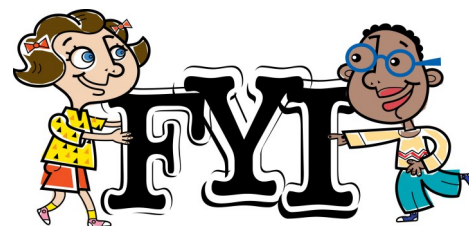

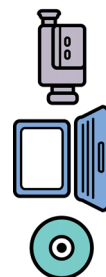
Redeeming 'Wasted' Time

In *Just Like Jesus*, Max Lucado writes that the average American spends a total of six months waiting at stoplights, eight months opening junk mail, 18 months looking for items we've lost and five years standing in line. All the while, many of us grumble: "What a waste of time! I could be doing something much more important! *Where* are my keys?"

But Lucado suggests that we give these moments to God. Rather than whispering to ourselves, we can speak to God in prayer. "Simple phrases such as 'Thank you, Father,' 'Be sovereign in this hour, O Lord,' 'You are my resting place, Jesus' can turn a commute into a pilgrimage," he writes. "You needn't leave your office or kneel in your kitchen. Just pray where you are. Let the kitchen become a cathedral or the classroom a chapel. Give God your whispering thoughts."

When we do this, "the common becomes uncommon," Lucado adds. What's more, "wasted" time becomes valuable; boring waits become meditative; the lost — your time, if not also your keys — is redeemed.

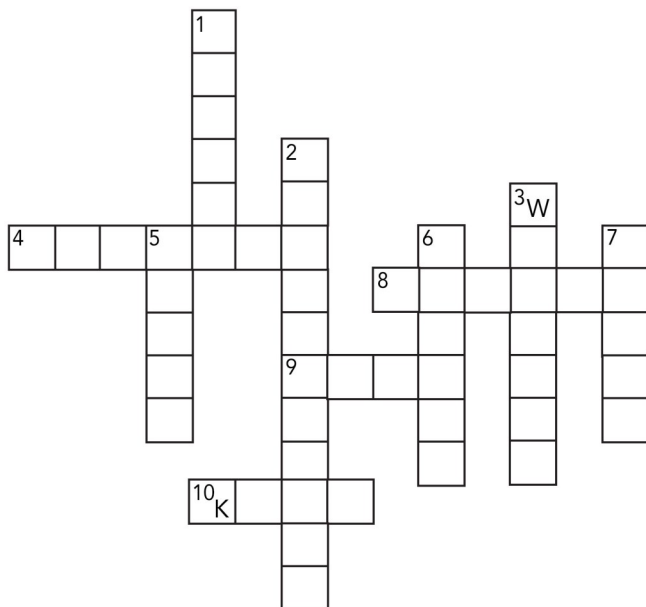

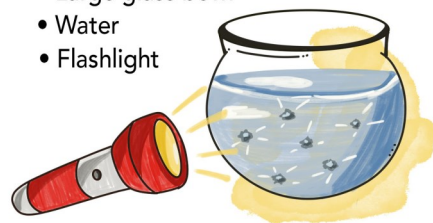

Why do stars appear to twinkle? Try this experiment to find out!

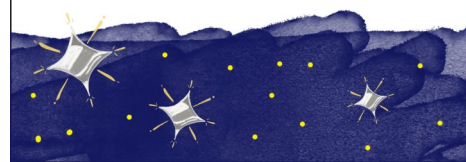
What you need:

- Aluminum foil
- Large glass bowl
- Water
- Flashlight



What you do:

1. Crumple the foil into a ball. Carefully unfold it and lay it flat on the ground.
2. Fill the bowl with water and place it on the foil.
3. Turn off the lights and make the room as dark as possible. Shine the flashlight about 1 foot from the water's undisturbed surface. Light will reflect onto the foil.
4. Then tap your finger on the water's surface. As the water moves, what happens to the light on the foil?
5. This flickering simulates scintillation, which happens when starlight enters Earth's atmosphere. As light passes through layers of gas and water, it refracts and appears to twinkle.
