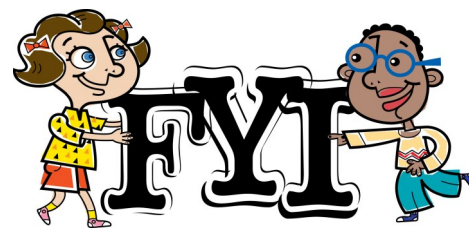

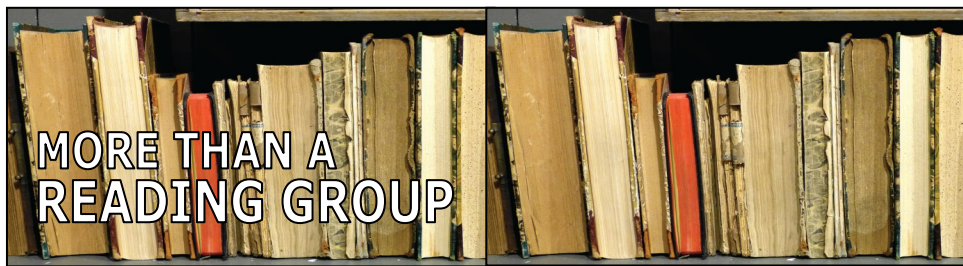

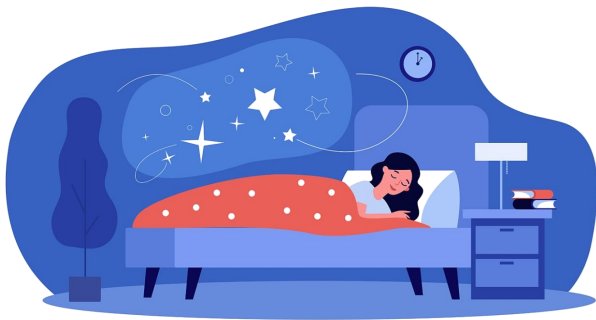

From the Health Ministry Team...



Sleep! One of my favorite things to do! As a night shifter for over 30 years, I know the benefits of a good night's rest! School is starting soon, and a good night's rest is very important for a successful year for children and parents! Sleep is crucial for good health!

The way you feel while you are awake depends in part on what happens while you are sleeping. During sleep, your body is working to support healthy brain function and maintain your physical health.

In children and teens, sleep also helps support growth and development. Getting inadequate sleep over time can raise your risk for chronic health problems. It can also affect how well you think, react, work, learn, and get along with others.

Research from the National Institute of Health shows that four key sleep factors are crucial to protect your health:

1. Good quality uninterrupted sleep
2. 7-8 hours of sleep each night for adults
3. Regular bedtime and wake-up time every day
4. Exposure to sunlight during the day

Practice healthy habits during the day: exercise regularly but not within 2-3 hours before bedtime. Don't take naps after 3:00 pm. Avoid caffeine and nicotine. Avoid alcoholic drinks before bed. Avoid large meals and drinks late at night. Avoid medicines that delay or disrupt sleep if possible. Create a good sleeping environment and take time to relax before going to bed: read a book, listen to music, and turn off the TV and electronic devices, and/or take a hot bath to help you relax.

God loves us and wants us to rest well. The Bible often talks about sleep as a gift from God for peace and safety. Psalm 4:8 - "In peace I will lie down and sleep, for you alone, Lord, make me dwell in safety."

The Indiana Annual Conference gathered at
St. Luke's United Methodist Church in
Indianapolis, Indiana, June 5-8, 2024.

PLENARY HIGHLIGHTS

- The 2025 budget was adopted.
- 13 churches were acknowledged for their many years of changing lives, though they disbanded in the last year.

CELEBRATION OF LIFE

The Conference honored the lives of 22 clergy and 24 spouses who have joined the Church Triumphant in the last year.

EPISCOPAL ADDRESS

Bishop Julius C. Trimble presented his episcopal address. "God deserves our praise, United Methodists. Because God's love never fails, never ends, and never runs out on us!" he said.

CELEBRATION OF MINISTRY HIGHLIGHTS

- 32 retirees were honored for their 664 years of combined service.
- 1 person was ordained as deacon.
- 3 persons were ordained as elders.
- 2 persons were commissioned for ministry as elders.
- 5 persons were recognized for their completion of Course of Study.
- 2 persons were commissioned as deaconesses.
- Rev. Dr. Javier Viera (President of Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary) offered words of inspiration in his sermon, "Sent Into the Unknown."

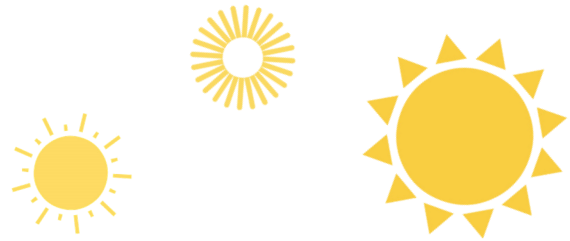

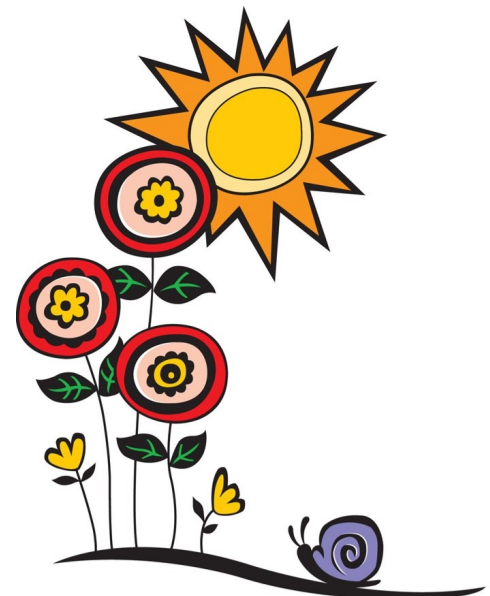

You don't have to visit the beach to make a sandcastle. Make fluffy "moon sand" to build fun structures.

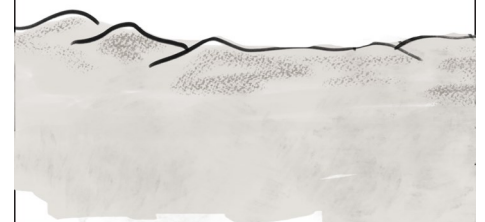
What you need:

- Large bowl
- Wooden spoon
- 8 cups flour
- 1 cup baby oil



What you do:

1. Measure flour into the large bowl. Add baby oil.
2. Mix thoroughly until all the oil is combined and the texture is consistent. If needed, use your hands to knead the mixture.
3. The sand is ready when it sticks together to form a ball when pressed in your hands.
4. Use sand toys and molds to create a sandcastle. Store sand in an airtight container for up to two weeks.

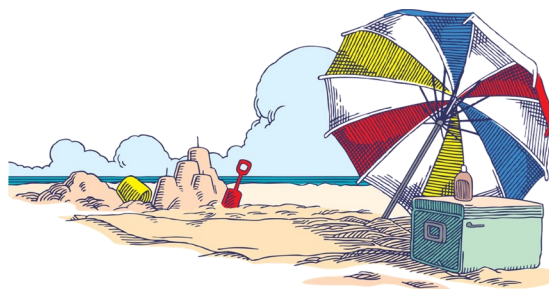
