The pacing is perfect, with a careful balance between heart-pounding action and poignant moments of reflection.

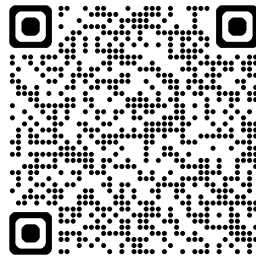

Another story involves a Parkinson friend who thought using a rolling walker was not needed. She had become afraid to take steps without her husband at her side. I brought a walker from the church's supply and within an hour she had increased her step width and confidence. She now has a brand-new walker (in her favorite color) and feels better with her movement. A friend who was going to have a hip replaced, wanted everything in place before his surgery. He was grateful to have walker ready to assist with his recovery. Walkers, hospital beds, and other health equipment have been used for post op and end of life care. Thank you to all who have donated supplies and have also put the word out for use. We ask that you sign out the equipment on the clip board. Thank you for prayers over the supplies and people using them.

## From the Health Ministry Team...

From the time we are preschoolers, we've often said, "It's my turn." My turn to get a drink, my turn to be rewarded, and my turn in a game situation. There are also times when it is our turn to face a health crisis.

I had often heard the statistics in my 40's that Breast Cancer is rarely diagnosed for women under 45. In my 70's, I learned the median age for diagnosis of breast cancer is 62. Just before my 72nd birthday, I learned it was my turn to be diagnosed with breast cancer. You may be surprised to know, as I was, that it didn't send me down a rabbit hole. Honestly, my initial response to the diagnosis was "it's okay, it's my turn." You see from the very beginning I knew I had a supportive and loving family, access to good medical care, friends who would be there for me and a church that would pray with me. I felt blessed because I knew of others who didn't have half those tools in their weapon's arsenal.

I just had my 73rd birthday and am now cancer free. My prognosis is excellent with over a 90% survival rate of more than 5 years and not much less than that for a survival rate of 10 years. I had a quick and immediate diagnosis, a treatment plan, and the tools necessary to navigate this medical journey. I'm sure there are many great doctors in a variety of healthcare systems, but I went to Hendricks Regional Health and started my journey with Dr. Natalie Mattingly. Our plan was to have a lumpectomy followed by 16 treatments of radiation with the awesome Dr. Given's oncology department and his team of great caregivers. This group of sensitive and caring women included two past members from AUMC. That was incredibly comforting and made a daily ritual seem like a walk to the mailbox. In and out in no time. I can't say enough about the continuum of care with HRH.

What I also cannot say enough about is the love and support of my church family. I received cards, calls and constant reminders that I and my team of health care professionals were being prayed for daily. How reassuring to know that you have prayer warriors who are lifting you up, especially in times of trial and medical issues. You may know that I am a 42 year member of this congregation and "if you can't hear me, I'll say it a little louder." I AM A 42 YEAR MEMBER OF AVON UNITED METHODIST CHURCH. I'm so thankful to my Rudgate neighbors who invited me to join them at their church some 40 years ago.

I was asked to say something about how else our church can be of help in these types of situations. I would say to keep doing what we do and pray for each other. Reach out during the journey and not just at the beginning with cards, texts, offer to run errands, provide a meal or gift card to local restaurants, and to ask them when is a good time to call or visit. Don't be offended if you are not taken up on that offer and check in later in the journey. The greatest gift we can do is pray for them. I knew you were doing that for me, and I felt God's presence at all times.

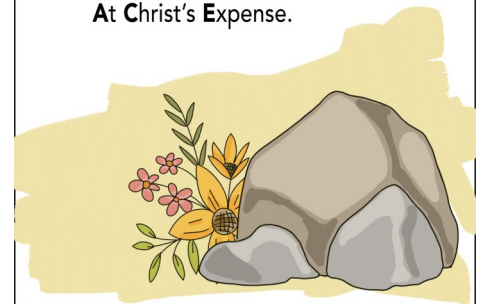


### What you need:
