


From the Health Ministry Team...






Blood Pressure Checks

Turban Cutting Workshop

The 2nd turban cutting workshop for 2025 will be on May 20th from 5:00 -7:45 pm with set up starting at 4:00 pm. We have many bright fabrics for spring and summer waiting to be transformed into our cute cancer turbans. Have you seen someone wearing them or perhaps you have a close friend or relative who has benefited from them? Have you ever wondered how the process works? They are truly a labor of love by our church with many steps required to make the finished product. First thing needed is the funds to purchase fabric done by a dedicated volunteer. Funds come from church accounts and donations of money or fabric. Then a workshop is scheduled quarterly to cut the fabrics. Next, our volunteer sewers take the cut turbans home and sew them. Some of the sewers aren't even members of our church but they want to be a part of this mission. Sewers return the finished turbans then they are counted and sorted. Next volunteers label them with stickers letting the recipients know they are gifts from Avon UMC. Finally, they are separated into bags of 50 then more volunteers deliver them to the hospital and clinic sites where they are given out freely! Whew, that took time and effort, but what a special gift from our church family!

We can't get the process going without a lot of helpers. No experience necessary. Bring your own scissors or use ones provided. Come as you can and stay as long as you can. For more information, contact Jane DuMond at bjdumond@sbcglobal.net.






The guest speaker for the United Women in Faith spring tea will be Rev. Meredith McNabb, Associate Superintendent of the Central District of INUMC.

In her early career, Meredith was an attorney, working primarily with low-income victims of domestic violence and on end-of-life planning in rural parts of Virginia. That work led her to answer her call to ministry, working to point out God's transformative hope and grace in the world. Meredith is completing her internship as a spiritual director with the Benedictine sisters in Beech Grove, and she and her spouse, Mike Davis, live in Indianapolis with their elderly terrier, Murphy.

In *Rest Your Dreams on a Little Twig*, poet Joyce Rupp finds in spring flowers the proclamation of the gospel: "we who have died / are alive today." In another poem in the same volume, she writes: "A green shoot grows / out of an old tree stump, / announcing to the world / that power lies within death."

As you move about outdoors these springtime days in the northern hemisphere, where do you see nature testifying to resurrection? Where is evidence that what seemed dead — bare branches, dry grass, inactive seeds — was not in fact the final word? What encourages you to believe in renewal, second chances, life that blossoms from death? In what ways are you, who had died, alive today? Part of your life that felt like an old stump might be sprouting green shoots after all!



Make these sweet sandwiches for a Mother's Day tea party.

What you need:

- 4 oz. cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 3 Tablespoons powdered sugar
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- 6-10 strawberries, washed
- and sliced6 slices of
- white bread





What you do:

- 1. With an electric mixer, whip the cream cheese in a bowl until fluffy.
- 2. Add cream, powdered sugar, and lemon juice. Continue whipping on high speed until mixture is stiff.
- 3. On each slice of bread, spread a layer of the mixture. Then arrange some sliced strawberries on top.
- 4. Place the sandwiches together, with filling on the inside.
- 5. Wrap tightly in cellophane. Chill for two hours so the filling sets.
- 6. Trim off crusts with a serrated knife. Cut sandwiches in squares or triangles. Serve and enjoy!
